In the reference cited, notifications were issued for the conduct of direct and indirect elections to GHMC.

Aggrieved parties if any may approach the Hon'ble High Court by way of filing writ petitions to stall the election process. In order to avoid unpleasant situations and untoward consequences in the Hon'ble High Court, timely action has to be taken to file the counters on the writ petition filed by the aggrieved parties.

Therefore, the Election Authority & Commissioner & Special Officer, GHMC is requested to entrust the work of filing counters and monitoring the hearing of cases in the Hon'ble High Court, in cases where he is impleaded as a party and the facts of the case are only in his knowledge, to a senior officer, who is well versed with election matters. The officer nominated for this purpose may be directed to co-ordinate with Advocate General, Government Pleader, Standing Counsel and Advisor (Legal) of the Commission and ensure that counters are filed effectively and well in advance.


The name, designation and contact number of the officer nominated for the above purpose may be intimated to the Commission for record.
