Sub:- GHMC elections, 2009 – Instructions regarding setting up of election booths by candidates on the day of poll – Reg.

Ref:- SEC Circular No.640/SEC-F1/2005, dt:5.8.2005.

Detailed instructions were issued in the reference cited in the matter of setting up of the election booths by candidates on the date of poll beyond a distance of 200 meters from the polling stations. It is stipulated therein that even where more than one polling station has been setup in the same building or premises there shall be only one booth of a candidate for such group of polling stations.

Some of the political parties have represented to the State Election Commission to permit setting up of election booths proportionate to the number of polling stations set up in a building or premises.

**The State Election Commission, after careful consideration of the matter, hereby, permits setting up of two election booths, if more than two polling stations are set up in a building or premises.**

Other stipulations made in the circular cited remain unchanged. It is hereby, reiterated that election booth shall be set up beyond 200 meters from the polling station and only with one table and two chairs with an umbrella or a piece of tarpaulin or cloth to protect the two occupants. Only one banner of 3

feet by 4 ½ feet in length and breadth may be displayed showing the name of the candidate/ party/election symbol at the booth.

This instruction to be brought to the notice of all concerned including Observers and Candidates.
